Club Rules

1. Eligibility for membership shall be decided by The Committee and such will be final and binding provided that refusal of membership of the Club does not contravene any European nor United Kingdom law.
2. The Committee is under no obligation to provide a reason for refusal of any application.
3. All prospective Members must be 21 years of age or more.
4. Membership of the Club is conditional upon the Member accepting and abiding by these Rules and the Member acknowledges that these Rules are binding upon and enforceable against the Member by the Club and The Committee.
5. Albert's may at its sole discretion choose to either suspend and/or cancel a membership of the Club.
6. No animals can be brought into the Club save for dogs for the visually impaired.
7. All Members must pay their Membership Fee yearly, or quarterly if under 30, and if the Membership Fee remains unpaid, membership will automatically terminated and will need to be re-applied for.
8. The management may in its sole discretion refuse any of the Members' guests entry.
9. All guests must be signed into the Club and must remain with the Member at all times.
10. The Member shall be responsible for any unpaid bills of her/his guests.

11. The Club will hold all information on its Members in the strictest confidence and will not divulge nor share it without the Member's prior written agreement.
12. Any Member may request a copy of the information held on him/her under the Data Protection Act 1998. Any requests must be in writing to: Data Controller, Beaufort House Private Members' Club, 354 Kings Road, London SW3 5UZ.
13. A Member may terminate her/his membership at any given time giving no less than two months written notice delivered to the Membership Secretary by letter or email.
14. No reimbursement will be made for any remaining time left on a membership.
15. Respect Albert's as if it were your home.
16. No drunkenness, bad language or other misconduct is permitted.
17. Mobile device photography is not permitted. We ask that speaking on the phone is conducted outside the Club.
18. Please ensure your guests are suitably behaved – they are your responsibility. The management of the Club may in their sole discretion request a Member and any of her/his friends to leave the premises.
19. Reservations are strongly recommended. Each Member is allowed three guests, unless dining, subject to legal capacity.
20. Guests may not remain in Albert's once the sponsoring Member has left.
